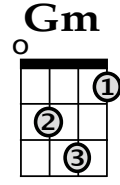
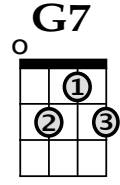
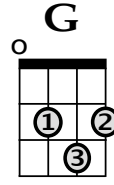
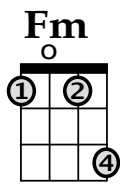
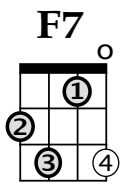
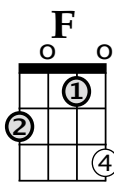
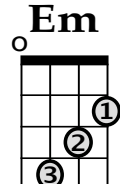
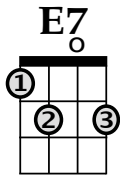
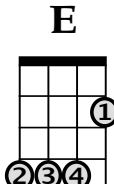
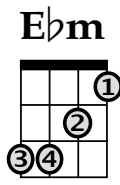
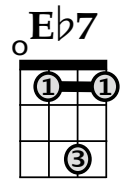
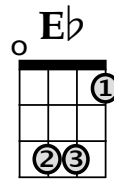
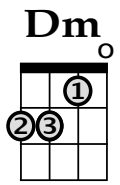
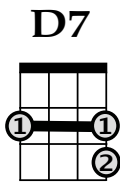
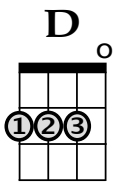
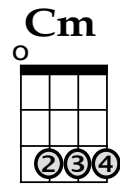
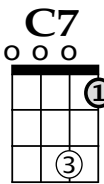
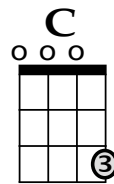
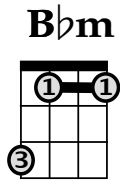
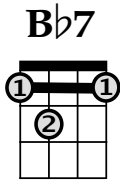
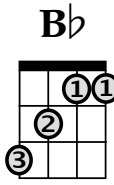
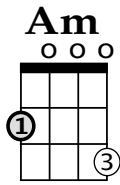
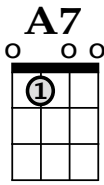
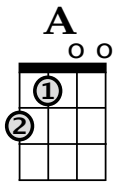
FOR SOPRANO, CONCERT AND TENOR UKULELES IN STANDARD TUNING: G - C - E - A

These are the five most common keys, or Chord Families, for the ukulele, known as *CAGFD*. The 1, 4 and 5 chords are the **Major** Chords and the 2, 3 and 6 chords are the **Minor** Chords. The 5 chord can also be a **Seventh** Chord.
